GRADE 3-4

This term in 3-4, we've been engaged in a variety of exciting and educational activities! One of the highlights was having Oakie's puppy, Penny, visit our class. The students loved playing with her and giving her lots of belly rubs. In math, we've been focusing on decimals and how to represent them, which has been a great way to deepen our number sense. We have also been collecting bottle lids and finding efficient ways to group them for easier counting. This hands-on activity has helped the class develop their place value knowledge and problem-solving skills.

As part of our Living Things unit, we grew bean seeds and observed their growth over 28 days. We experimented with two different conditions: bean seeds in soil and bean seeds in cotton wool, to see which setup would help the seeds grow faster. The students tracked their growth carefully and learned about what plants need to thrive. It's been a fun and productive term so far and we cannot wait to share more of our learning with you throughout the year!
