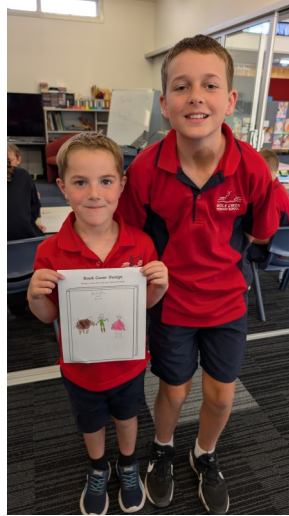
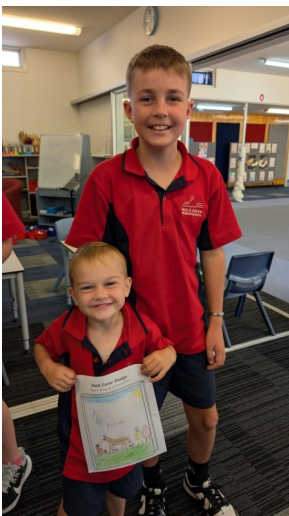
Reminder that our first school assembly will be held in the open area on Monday 3rd March at 2pm. Please ensure that you sign in at the office to en-
