## Safeguarding

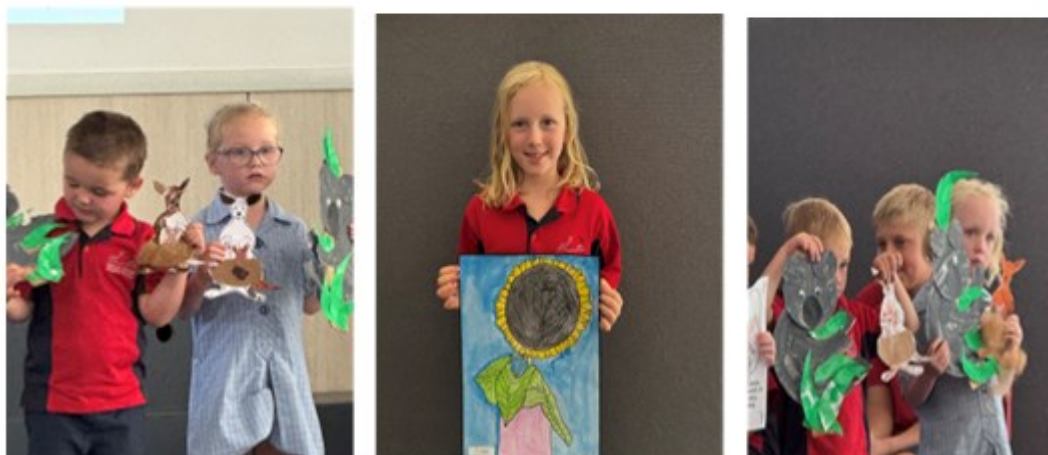

*Cost:* nil (usually \$150 per person)

*Course details:*

“The first aid course teaches the skills and knowledge to recognise emergencies and provide immediate and effective first aid treatment to any person suffering a sudden illness or injury.

The following units will be included in your certificate:

HLTAID011 - Provide First Aid

HLTAID009 - Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

HLTAID010 - Provide basic emergency life support”
